



KINGSWOOD HALL OF FAME - BYLAWS

Mission Statement

The Kingswood Hall of Fame will seek to recognize and honor achievements by those who have represented, contributed, and dedicated themselves to Kingswood Athletics. Accomplishments recognized will focus on participation and citizenship highlighting the Kingswood Athletic community.

Qualifications to be Nominated

To be nominated for the Kingswood Hall of Fame an individual or team must:

- Display outstanding achievement in their respective sport (team or individual). This could be during one's high school career and/or accomplishments at the next level(s).
- Be an accomplished individual who has given meritorious dedicated service to the athletic programs at Kingswood.
- Nominations for athletes will adhere to an eight (8) year grace period upon the year of accomplishment (team) or graduation (individual).
- Athletes must have graduated from Kingswood Regional High School.

Automatic Nominations will be accepted by the Hall of Fame committee, given the following criteria is met:

- 1) State Championship attained by either an Individual or a Team** (inducted 8 years after the year of accomplishment).
- 2) Olympian** (inducted immediately following completion of Olympic competition).
- 3) Professional athlete.**

Nomination Process

- 1) Completed nominations must include a Hall of Fame application/nomination form and be submitted to the Hall of Fame committee by the annual deadline.
- 2) No nomination forms will be considered unless proper supporting evidence and the application/nomination form is completed in its entirety.

Hall of Fame Committee

The purpose of the committee will be to:

- Select inductees from the nominations presented.
- Assist with the annual planning and execution of the Hall of Fame festivities.

The Hall of Fame committee shall consist of 7-9 members:

- 1) Current High School Athletic Director
- 2) Current High School Principal
- 3) Booster Club Officer
- 4) One current or former Kingswood Head Coach
- 5) At-Large community representatives who are Kingswood Alumni and lettered in at least one Varsity sport
- 6) Members of the community school or otherwise with significant knowledge of Kingswood Athletics
- 7) Student Athlete Leadership Team (SALT) / Captain Council student representative

The athletic director shall conduct the Hall of Fame Committee meetings and receive absentee ballots from committee members who are unable to attend a selection meeting.

For the committee to conduct a selection meeting from nominations submitted, a majority of the committee must be present (5 of 9 committee members).

Committee member terms shall be for 3 years.

In the inaugural year of the Hall of Fame, committee terms are as follows:

- 3 members will serve for 1 year.
- 3 members will serve for 2 years.
- 3 members will serve the full term of 3 years.

Hall of Fame Induction

- 1) A nominee must receive a 2/3 vote to be inducted.
- 2) Any nominee not selected will remain as an active nominee for future consideration.
- 3) The Hall of Fame Committee will host a dedicated event to recognize the new and past inductees.
- 4) In the event that the Hall of Fame committee does not meet their nomination threshold in any given year, the committee reserves the right to nominate nominees at their discretion.
